

Transforming Women's Lives in Afghanistan
Earlier this year our parish raised £500 towards the Durham Christian
Aid network's fundraising target of £5,000 to support women's education
in Afghanistan. The group met its target and in fact we've raised more
like £6,000 altogether, in record time! This money will be multiplied three
times by match funding from the European Union, so Durham's support
will have real impact in one of the poorest countries in the world. THANK
YOU for your support. There will be an opportunity to hear all about the
project, and about the work of Christian Aid more widely, at November's
Mothers' Union meeting - details to follow.
