News from Durham Christian Aid Group fundraising for Afghanistan

*I'm delighted to let you know that the Durham Christian Aid group (which includes representatives from sixteen churches across the city) has now exceeded its target and raised £5,500 to help fund a Christian Aid project in Afghanistan.
